1. Third Information Session on Preliminary G10 Streaming Results for 2018-19: G9 students must complete a Preliminary G10 Streaming by Monday, 9 April 2018 at home using the online system for G10 streaming. Parents are encouraged to offer advice and assistance to their sons on the selection of elective subjects. The results of the Preliminary Streaming will be disclosed in the Third Information Session at 11:35 a.m. on Wednesday, 9 May 2018 in the School Hall. All G9 students must attend. Parents are welcome. Please note that no parking is available.

2. Grades 7, 8 and 9 Final English Oral Examinations: The Final English Oral Examinations will be held after school on 7, 10 and 14 May respectively. Students who fail to attend the exams will receive no mark.

3. G11 English SBA (CORE section-Crime Film): 7 to 18 May G10 English TRIAL SBA: 18 to 31 May

6. <u>Inter-School Athletics Competition 2017-18</u>: We have captured the overall championship for the sixth consecutive year. Congratulations to all the masters-in-charge, coaches and athletes for their dedication.

Team training started in August and took place every Monday, Wednesday and Friday after school. Our boys were encouraged to take part in the South China Inter-School Athletics Competition held in late November 2017.

Training continued during school holidays. We undertook four training sections during the Christmas holidays in lieu of the training camp that couldn't be held again due to limitations of accommodation. In addition, we had four training sessions during the Lunar New Year holidays – one of which fell on a public holiday. Over 40 boys attended each session to prepare for the competition which followed right after the holiday.

The Inter-School Athletics Competition this year was intense. In the midst of competition, our boys made several mistakes, but we remained ahead of our opponents on points through Days 1 and 2. However, we had to work for each additional point in every event to maintain our lead. Throughout, our boys showed confidence and the determination to win. Their fiery spirits and hearts were the most impressive aspect throughout the competition as they strove to capture the overall championship.

During the competition, we set 63 personal bests, 19 of them were in A Grade, 22 in B Grade and 22 in C Grade. Furthermore, we captured 11 gold medals, 13 silver medals and 13 bronze medals out of 43 events and broke two records.

Our efforts culminated in a 32-point lead at the end of all events; we came first in A Grade and C Grade and came a close second in B Grade. We were crowned champion for the sixth consecutive time. Thank you, boys, for your dedication to bringing glory to DBS.

Special thanks must be given to my colleagues, Mr. P. Cheng, Mr. Ricky Hui Wai Hei and Mr. Ho Mau Wang for their hard work; our school captains, Mr. Hue Sheung Chun and Mr. Wong King Hei for their wholehearted dedication. Their diligence is much appreciated and we will continue to do our best in the coming years.
