3. Examinations Affected by Inclement Weather: If the School is closed owing to inclement weather, affected examinations will be postponed to the Saturday of the same week. Other examinations will be held as scheduled. The TSA 2018 (written assessments) for G9 will take place on 19 and 20 June. If the assessments are interrupted by bad weather, they will be postponed to 22 June. 10. Release of G10 Class Lists: The results of the G10 streaming and choice of elective subjects will be released by Monday, 23 July. G9 students should check the results via the online system at http://www2.dbs.edu.hk/nssse. The School will also inform parents by a text message.

G9 students requesting a second round streaming should submit a completed request form to the General Office by Friday, 7 September. Late applications will NOT be entertained.
