

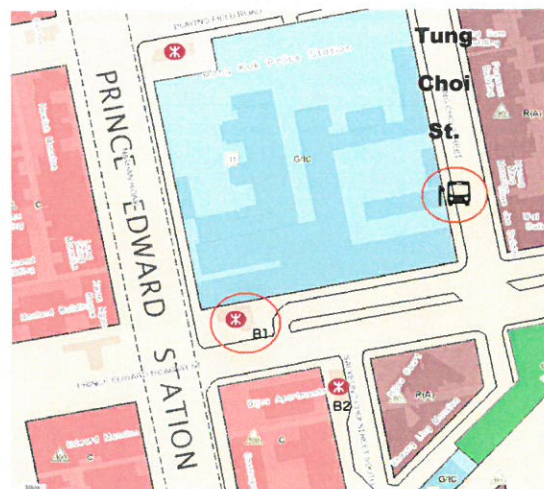

Please note the following:

1. **Garden Fete on 11 November 2018:** We cordially invite you to this year's Garden Fete from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Sunday, 11 November 2018. Your support for the School is greatly appreciated.
 - a. **Lunch** will be served by the Diocesan Boys' School Parent-Teacher Association Limited at HKD 220 per head (free for children aged 5 or below) from 12:00–1:30 p.m. and 1:30–3:30 p.m. Please make cheques payable to '**Diocesan Boys' School Parent-Teacher Association Limited**' and send them to Ms. M.C. Chan at the Library near the Main Building.
 - b. **A free shuttle bus service** for parents, students and visitors will be provided through Sun Bus Limited:

Route: Tung Choi Street outside Mong Kok Police Station (see Map) ⇌ the Primary Division

The bus has a capacity of 27 passengers and operates from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. at 15-minute intervals. The last bus leaves from the Primary Division at 4:00 p.m. Please understand that the traffic at Tung Choi Street is always busy and so the exact location for boarding the bus may need to be adjusted. - c. **Parking:** A limited number of spaces is available, but **no parking will be provided on a rainy day.** A long queue is expected on the School Drive to drop off passengers or look for parking and the wait usually exceeds 45 minutes. Once the parking lots are full, drivers will be asked to leave the School Drive to avoid congesting the only exit. No waiting is allowed in case of an emergency.

Therefore, we strongly recommend that parents and students avoid delays by taking the shuttle bus or walking up to the School via the Main Drive from Argyle Street or via the Steps from Prince Edward Road.

2. **Other Garden Fete Issues:**

- a. **Flag ceremonies:** All guests and students are required to stand and face the School Flag to show respect at the flag-raising ceremony at 10:00 a.m. and the flag-lowering ceremony at 5:00 p.m. When the first note of the School Hymn is played, everyone on the premises should come to attention. Game stalls will be temporarily suspended.
- b. **Game stalls:** In compliance with government licensing restrictions, the School observes the following protocol:-
- The **maximum value** of each prize **should not exceed HKD300.**
 - **Students are not allowed to collect cash;** only teachers-in-charge may handle cash.
 - Unused coupons from previous years are invalid and non-refundable.
 - Parents and students are advised to use up all current coupons at the Fete.
- c. **Housekeeping:** Adhesive tape should not be used on School walls or railings as the sticky residue is extremely difficult to remove.
- d. **Video recording:** The School has arranged for video recording of the Garden Fete by drones between 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Parents and students are advised to take note of this during their visit to the School, in particular during the opening ceremony.
3. **OLE Platform:** The accounts for G10 students are ready. Students can check their records by logging into their eClass account and clicking the “iPortfolio” icon in the upper right-hand corner of the page.
4. **First Term Tests for G7:** Schedules, mark weighting and syllabi are available via Parents’ eClass accounts.
5. **Information Session on the Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education (HKDSE) and the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP):** G9 parents and students are invited to the information session at **11:35 a.m. on Wednesday, 7 November** in the School Hall. Parents of G7 and G8 students are also welcome. The briefing will introduce the two curricula and compare the offers from both local and overseas universities granted to our recent HKDSE and IBDP graduates.

8. **Student Council 2018/19:** The Student Council Executive Committee Election was successfully held on 26 September 2018 from 12:00 noon to 4:30 pm. 740 students cast their votes to determine who would lead the council. The results are as follows: the cabinet comprising CHAN Hei Chit Ericsson (G11G), SO Ka Long Justin (G11L), WONG Tsun Hong Anthony (G11M) and LI Kin Hang Godric (G11D) received 53% of the votes, compared to 29% and 8% received by the other cabinets.
