7. <u>Inter-School Swimming Competition 2018</u>: The Inter-School Swimming Competition was held on 19 and 26 October, 2018 at Kowloon Park Swimming Pool. Our Team came 1st in A Grade, 1st in B Grade, 1st in C Grade and retained the Overall Championship again. This is our 26th consecutive year to win the Overall Trophy!

We won 6 events in A Grade, 6 in B Grade and 6 in C Grade.

Our congratulations go to all our swimmers.
