Third Information Session on Preliminary G10 Streaming Results for 2019-2020: G9 students must complete a Preliminary G10 Streaming by Monday, 8 April 2019 at home using the online system for G10 streaming. Parents are encouraged to offer advice and assistance to their sons on the selection of elective subjects. The results of the Preliminary Streaming will be disclosed in the Third Information Session at 11:35 a.m. on Wednesday, 15 May 2019 in the School Hall. All G9 students must attend. Parents are welcome. Please note that no parking is available.
- 4. Grade 9 Territory-wide System Assessment (TSA) 2019: The Secondary 3 Chinese and English TSA Oral Assessments will be conducted by HKEAA assessors on Tuesday, 30 April 2019. Random Grade 9 students will be selected by the HKEAA officials to take the TSA in the assessment rooms from 8:45-11:30 a.m. Selected students should bring their Student ID Cards and a pen or pencil. All other students will have normal lessons.
