The post-exam schedule for 2 July to 15 July will be issued in a separate circular.

Report Cards: On Monday, 8 July 2019, G9 Class Teachers will distribute copies of the Report Cards and the instructions entitled "G10 Streaming and Choice of Elective Subjects" and inform students of their Overall Form Position (whole year). Please remind students to submit their print-out of "G10 Streaming and Choice of Elective Subjects" on Friday, 12 July during the morning roll-call.

- 2. Examinations Affected by Inclement Weather: If the School is closed owing to inclement weather, affected examinations will be postponed to the Saturday of the same week. Other examinations will be held as scheduled. The TSA 2019 (written assessments) for G9 will take place on 18 and 19 June. If the assessments are interrupted by bad weather, they will be postponed to 21 June. G9 students requesting a second round streaming should submit a completed request form to the General Office by Friday, 6 September. Late applications will NOT be entertained. Results of the second round streaming are based on the availability of places in early September and will be released to individual applicants on Monday, 16 September.
