在課程上,本組特別為高中級編寫了以下的校本教材:《高中級校本文言文自學課程》、《高中級校本文言文延 伸課程》及《高中級校本白話文補充上下兩冊課程》,以配合新課程12篇章的考核,加強白話及文言篇章的閱 讀理解訓練。此外,為加強學生的寫作能力訓練,本組亦備有《高中級校本寫作補充課程》第二版及《高中級 校本論證手冊》,以迎合課改及考評的需要。除上述的校本教材外,本組所編寫兩套的《中華美格言》筆記, 期盼能增潤高中同學對中國文化的認識。至於初中級,中文組亦特別編寫了不同的校本課程,如初中級《校本 文言文自編課程》、《成語學習檔案》、《別字辨識手冊》、《邏輯教室》、《初中級校本寫作補充課程》、《初中級校 本論證手冊》、《初中級校本文化補充課程》及、《初中級校本語文知識補充課程》等,目的是希望鞏固初中同 學的語文基礎知識,為未來的文憑試鋪路。一如過往,為培養中一同學的自主學習態度,配合新高中中國語文 科的課程精神,本組繼續在圖書館設立自主學習角,延伸「自主學習」精神。懇請家長督促 貴子弟努力溫習, 共同為文憑試作好準備。

- <u>The S.J. Lowcock Foundation Scholarship</u>: This Scholarship enables our economically-disadvantaged students to continue with their tertiary education locally or overseas. Application forms can be obtained from the Dean of Students and the deadline for application is the end of April 2020.
- <u>The Jacland Lai Foundation Scholarship</u>: This Scholarship helps musically-gifted students or Old Boys to advance their musical achievement. Application forms can be obtained from the Dean of Students and the deadline for application is the end of April 2020.
- 13. <u>The George She Foundation Fund Award</u>: This Award aims to provide financial assistance to students of DBS to pursue their interest or advance their performance in extracurricular activities, in particular in the areas of sports and music. Application forms can be obtained from the Dean of Students and the deadline for application is the end of April 2020.
- 14. <u>The Terence Chang Award</u>: This Award is for deserving current boys who have shown outstanding achievement in their academic or creative pursuits. Awards shall be given out to students in both lower (G8 G9) and upper (G11 G12) grades. Application forms can be obtained from the Dean of Students and the deadline for application is the end of April 2020.
- 15. The Terence Chang Foundation: To encourage students to engage in more independent research under the guidance of teachers, the Terence Chang Foundation will award students a maximum of HK\$100,000 per annum for self-initiated project learning. Individual students working on their own projects can receive awards of up to HK\$10,000, while collaborating students can receive between \$20,000 and \$50,000, depending on the nature of their project. The money awarded must be used exclusively for the actualisation of the projects.

Application forms are obtainable in September from the Headmaster's Office. The deadline is the first Friday of January 2020. Results of the application will be announced in February 2020, and the awardees must complete their projects by the first Friday of September 2020. Detailed rules and regulations are provided on the application form.

16. Spirit of DBS Award: Grade 11 and 12 students can apply for the Spirit of DBS Award. The two winners will take part in a two- to three-week overseas summer programme which emphasises learning through "out-of-class" experiences. Students will be given an opportunity to participate in events beyond academic fields, such as cultural, sports and political events. Students can choose their own programmes of interest as long as they can fulfill the above criteria and receive the approval of the Headmaster. Alternatively, they can join a tailor-made programme by Old Boys and live with the families of Old Boys whilst participating in the programme. The Award aims to help develop future leaders through enriching experiences.

The Award fully covers all expenses and spending money for this programme, equivalent to HK\$25,000 per student. Application forms can be obtained from the Dean of Students and the deadline for application is the end of February 2020.
