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Please note the following:

1. Class allocation

The arrangement and criteria for tentative class allocation are detailed below. To maintain a consistent teaching and learning environment for students, G8 and 9 classes will be finalized if physical attendance of school does not resume by 14 September 2020.

G8	• Class in G7 (2019-2020) e.g., 7D → 8D; 7S → 8S (tentative until 14 Sept)	 Marked scripts and report cards will be distributed when physical attendance of school resumes. If physical attendance resumes on or before 14 Sept, the G8 Maths exam (2019-2020) will take place on the first day; class promotion to G8 and G9 (2020-2021) will be based on Annual Form Positions. If physical attendance resumes after 14 Sept, the G8 Math exam (2019-2020) will be cancelled; class promotion to G8 and G9 (2020-2021) will be based on original classes in the preceding year.
G9	• Class in G8 (2019-2020) e.g., 8D → 9D; 8S → 9S (tentative until 14 Sept)	
G10	G10 Streaming Results	Report cards will be distributed when physical attendance of school resumes.
G11	• Class in G10 (2019-2020) e.g., 10D → 11D; 10S →11S	Marked scripts and report cards will be distributed when physical attendance of school resumes.
G12	• Class in G11 (2019-2020) e.g., 11D → 12D; 11S →12S	Report cards will be distributed when physical attendance of school resumes.

3. Arrangements for online live lessons

Before physical attendance of school resumes, live lessons will be conducted according to the following arrangements:

- Live lessons will follow a special half-day timetable. Students are required to closely follow the timetable, which can be downloaded from the school's website.
- Afternoon sessions (14:30 16:00) are reserved for supplementary lessons, quizzes and tests, etc. Concerned students will be notified by their respective subject teachers.
- Roll-call will be taken every lesson.

Students are required to observe the following etiquette when attending live lessons:

- Be punctual.
- Dress appropriately and respectfully.
- Stay in a quiet environment with minimal distractions and mute your microphone except when you speak.
- Use a virtual background if you wish to maintain privacy.
- Turn on the camera and show your face throughout the live lesson.
- Display your name in a standardized format for roll-call.
