Please note the following:

- 1. <u>School Hours</u>: According to the 'Class Resumption Schedule' (SN/2009-103) issued 2 September 2020, the School will adopt a phased approach to class resumption. Classes at school will be conducted according to the special half-day timetable until further notice from EDB. School starts at 8:05 a.m. and ends at 1:20 p.m. Boys must be present for roll-call in their classrooms at 8:05 a.m.
- 2. <u>Week System:</u> Please refer to the attached calendar for first term school activities. Boys and parents are encouraged to browse the calendar on the school homepage (www.dbs.edu.hk) for the arrangements of the second term.
- 3. <u>Period 6 Arrangement for Grades 10, 11 & 12</u>: According to the timetable, some classes in Grades 10, 11 & 12 do not have lessons on Period 6 on various weekdays and may leave the School after Period 5.
- 4. <u>Use of Classroom Keys</u>: All Class Captains (or Representatives when Class Captains are absent) have to pick up their own classroom key in the morning at the General Office. The keys must be returned to the School Office immediately after school. Students must not duplicate keys or keep them overnight. All Class Captains should carry out their duties accordingly.
- 5. <u>Please Help Clean up the Classroom</u>: After the last period of every school day, students are requested to immediately clean up the classroom. It is important for students to maintain the tidiness of their own rooms.
- 6. <u>Traffic Arrangements</u>: As lessons end at 1:20 p.m. and the Primary Division lessons end at 12:45 p.m. from 23 September 2020 and 12:30 p.m. from 29 September 2020 until further notice, heavy traffic along the School Drive is anticipated. Please follow the instructions of our duty staff. Instead of picking their sons up at the School, parents are encouraged to collect them on Peace Avenue or the Embankment Road areas. If the traffic conditions along the School Drive worsen, the School will tighten up the traffic control measures and parents may not be allowed to drive up to the School to collect their sons.
- 7. <u>Application for Special Examination Arrangements</u>: The HKEAA has begun to accept applications for special examination arrangements (SEAs) from HKDSE candidates with special needs (2021 & 2022). The deadline for application is 7 October 2020. G11 & G12 students who have special needs and wish to apply should contact Ms Catherine Wong (dbskmw@dbs.edu.hk) by 16 September 2020 to make the necessary arrangements.

Applications submitted after the application deadline will NOT be accepted. Please refer to the following link for further information.



8. Absences from Tests and Examinations: Tests and examinations are an integral part of formative and summative assessments, thus students are expected to attend all school assessments. Schedules will be provided in advance to prevent absences due to clashes with personal matters. Students will receive a zero for missed tests and examinations. In these cases, the School allows a formal written appeal addressed to the Headmaster which includes a completed Application Form obtainable via the School website at <a href="http://www2.dbs.edu.hk/academics/absenceform.pdf">http://www2.dbs.edu.hk/academics/absenceform.pdf</a> or via the General Office.

The Application Form should be <u>submitted</u> with relevant supporting documents to the Dean of <u>Studies at least 10 working days before the scheduled test or examination</u>. Only exceptional or unavoidable circumstances are considered acceptable excuses, e.g. the student is competing as a representative of the School or Hong Kong. Other excuses will be considered case by case and are subject to approval at the discretion of the Headmaster. Due to specific requirements set by the International Baccalaureate Organization, IB students should refer to the DBS IB Policies and Guidelines.

- 9. <u>Promotion & Repeat Policy</u>: The School requires that students demonstrate a set standard of academic achievements before progressing to the next grade level. Students who do not reach this standard at the end of a year are required to repeat the year by joining a class of younger students the following academic year. **14.** <u>Instrumental Class — Small Group Classes for Violin and Viola:</u> Every year, the School organises weekly classes for students. Notices will be distributed in eClass for registration. Interested students should submit a reply slip and relevant supporting material to Miss Holly Wong (Telephone: 2768 5643) by post on or before Monday, 18 September.

- **15.** <u>Junior English Oral Exams</u>: Students and parents of Grades 7–9 should note the following dates of the Term 1 oral assessments:
  - G7 Wednesday, 11 November
  - G8 Friday, 13 November
  - G9 Monday, 16 November

Each oral exam is worth 10% of students' overall mark in English and will take place after school. Parents should ensure that their child is available on their examination day. Students who fail to show up for the exam will be given a mark of '0'.

- 16. G7, 8 and 9 English Reading Assignment & Book Reports: To promote active reading among G7, 8 and 9 students outside of lessons, English Literature teachers will assign four book reports (two per term) this year. Students should choose and read works of fiction and non-fiction outside the syllabus on their own. Those who fail to complete all book reports will find the remark 'Incomplete English Homework' on their Mid-year and/or Final School Reports. On top of the compulsory assignments, a recommended reading list will be distributed. Please encourage your child to develop a habit of reading and to look for books that are personally engaging and academically challenging.
