Examination Regulations

1. During the examination period, students are required to go to school only when they have to attend examinations.
2. There will be no makeup examination even if a student is sick on an examination day.
3. Students **must be in proper school uniform** when they attend examinations. Those who violate the uniform policy will be punished.
4. Students must **check their body temperature before going to school** on every examination day. They should **record their temperature on the temperature record form and bring the form with them. If a student has fever or acute respiratory tract infection symptoms, he should not attend the examination but consult a doctor promptly.**
5. The body temperature of all students will be checked upon arrival on campus. **Students must wear surgical masks on campus at all times.**
6. (a) Students sitting an examination in the school hall should assemble in the covered areas outside the Biology, Integrated Science, Chemistry, Physics and General Science Laboratories **at least 10 minutes before the examination** is due to start.
(b) Students sitting an examination in **classrooms** should assemble in **the covered playground at least 10 minutes before the examination** is due to start.
7. Students must **maintain absolute silence** once they have entered the examination room.
8. Students should be seated according to the seating plan posted at the entrance of the examination room.
9. **Students are strongly advised not to bring any electronic device** (such as tablet, multimedia player, electronic dictionary, databank watch, smart watch or other wearable technologies with communication or data storage functions) to an examination. If a student has any of the above electronic devices, it must be switched off and put under his chair in a position clearly visible to the invigilators. If any of the above electronic devices is found on his desk, in the drawer of his desk, in his pockets or on his body during an examination, he may be **disqualified from the examination.**
10. If the use of calculators is allowed in an examination, the calculators must have been pad-printed with the "H.K.E.A.A. APPROVED" or "H.K.E.A. APPROVED" label. Students bringing a calculator without the required label to an examination will risk a **mark penalty**. Students are required to remove the calculator cover/jacket and place it inside their bag or under their chair during the examination.
11. No student is permitted to leave early in an examination.
12. Late comers are permitted to sit an examination but no extra time will be given. The chief invigilator should record the names and the arrival time of all late comers in the Sessional Report.
13. If a student wants to go to the toilet during an examination, he must seek permission from an invigilator. He is not allowed to have his wallet or any electronic device in his pockets or on his body when he goes to the toilet. He is required to record his name, the time he leaves and returns to the examination room on a record form. Only one student is allowed to go to the toilet at a time. No extra time will be given.
