Tennis: Team A (1 hour / week: Fridays) Team B (1 hour / week: Mondays) *No training in July & August 	<p>To aim for getting good results in the 2006-2007 Primary School Sports Award organized by the Hong Kong Schools Sports Federation. Part-time professional sports coaches will be employed to conduct training sessions in order to provide elite training for students and to reduce the workload of full time PE teachers. Over 200 school team members will benefit from the training programme.</p> <p>The part-time sports coaches identified are international / professional coaches and / or outstanding athletes with experience and knowledge in conducting specific training. We require these professionals to train our students and prepare them for both inter- and intra-school competitions.</p>	<p>From mid-September 2006 to late-August 2007, excluding test and exam weeks.</p> <p>There will be 2-3 weekly training sessions for each school sports team, namely Badminton, Basketball, Football, Fencing, Table-Tennis and Tennis.</p> <p>Coaches will train students for the following competitions:</p> <p>-Inter-School Sports Competitions (Badminton: Nov, Feb-Mar; Basketball: Mar; Football: Nov-Dec; Fencing: Apr; Table-Tennis: Nov & May; Tennis: Jan-Mar)</p> <p>LCSD Easy Sports Competitions: (Badminton & Table-Tennis: Feb & May; Basketball: May; Fencing: May)</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1.
